

All net proceeds from World Kindness Concert 2004 are donated to the **Invest in a Kinder World “Coin-spiracy,”** a program developed to engage schools and youth groups in creating positive global change.

The Coin-spiracy

The Coin-spiracy revolves around the launch and tracking of a kindness coin called a UNI - short for the universal nature of kindness. To launch the UNI, the participating school or youth group commits three kind acts: one for self, one for the environment, and one for another. Then, the coin is passed on to the recipient of the kind act who in turn commits the three kind acts and passes it on. As each UNI Coin is uniquely coded, its amazing kindness adventures can be tracked through the campaign web site, www.investinakinderworld.com.

The first Coin-spiracy campaign was piloted in November 2002 and was a heart-warming success with 63 schools in B.C. participating, over 100,000 acts of humanitarian service performed, \$30,000 raised in donations for communities in need, 14 countries reached, and more lives touched than can ever be measured.

In the second Coin-spiracy launch (November 2003), 77 schools and youth groups in 12 countries invested over 171,571 hours in creating a kinder world and raised over \$190,784 to provide essentials for others in need locally and in over 35 other countries.

These incredible stories are just the beginning.... Coin-spiracy participants' investment in kind acts will multiply as the recipients of their kind acts join the Coin-spiracy tradition and commit three more acts of kindness and pass their UNIs along. In just two years, the Coin-spiracy campaign has positively impacted people and communities in over 45 countries. As the UNI Coins continue to pass hands, the ripples of kindness will spread and the likelihood of the Coin-spiracy touching lives in every country seems within the realm of possibility.... Imagine.

The Coin-spiracy is a project of the KindActs Network Association of B.C., a non-profit Society with a mission to inspire human connection and activate the practice of kindness locally and globally. KindActs is now in its seventh year of making a difference in the community locally through its programs and events and globally through its membership in the World Kindness Movement.

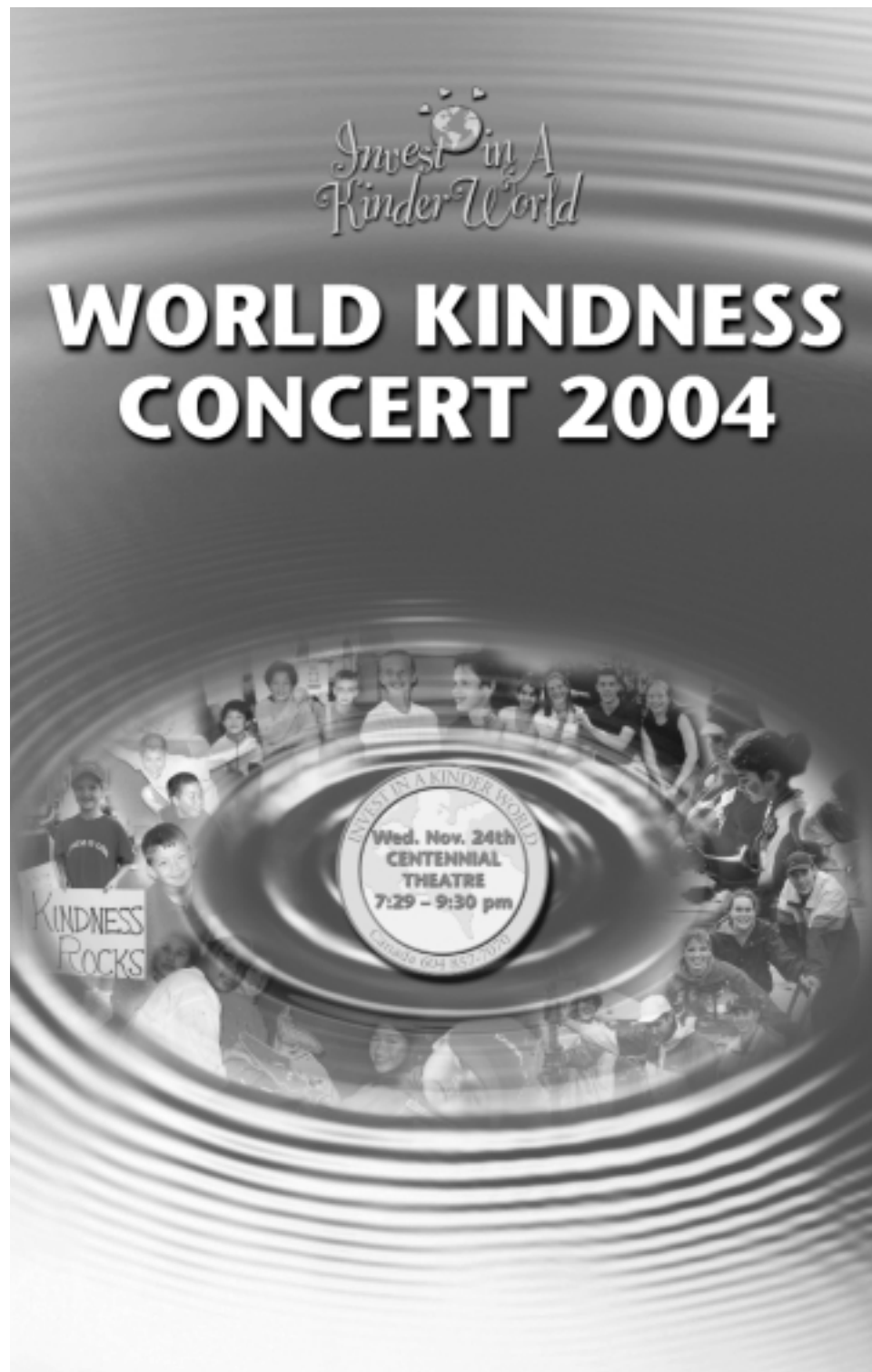
